



Code of Conduct

By joining CHDC, all members are automatically bound by the code of conduct below. Participation in the Club's activities is subject to observance of the Club's Code of Conduct and rules. Any non-compliance with the Code of Conduct may, at the sole discretion of the Chairperson and Committee of the Club, result in disciplinary action which may include temporary suspension, cancellation of membership or any other action deemed appropriate.

1. Members shall recognise that the primary aim of the Club is for the benefit of the dogs and that all actions shall be guided by this priority.
2. The Club values inclusiveness and diversity; all members are expected to make others feel welcome and supported in their training efforts.
3. Members shall treat each other with care, respect, courtesy and consideration.
4. Members are expected to act in a constructive, harmonious and supportive manner towards each other.
5. Members shall at all times behave in an honest and ethical manner.
6. No member shall bring the name of the Club into disrepute.
7. No member shall use abusive language nor be discourteous or rude to any other member or trainer.
8. Members shall always fully co-operate and follow the instructions of Club trainers and other staff.
9. Members using the Club's social media platforms shall do so in a manner that supports the image of the Club and upholds the code of conduct and any other rules or guidelines.
10. Members shall not use the Club or its premises for commercial activity without the express written permission of the Chairperson. No member may sell any animal, product or service without this permission.
11. Members shall not engage in any activity that endangers the life, safety, health or wellbeing of any other member or dog.
12. Any disagreements should, if not able to be resolved constructively between the parties, be brought to the attention of the Chairperson for further action.
13. CHDC do not accept any responsibility for any injury and/or loss of life to any person and/or dog on our premises, nor any damage to, or theft of, property and/or dog.
